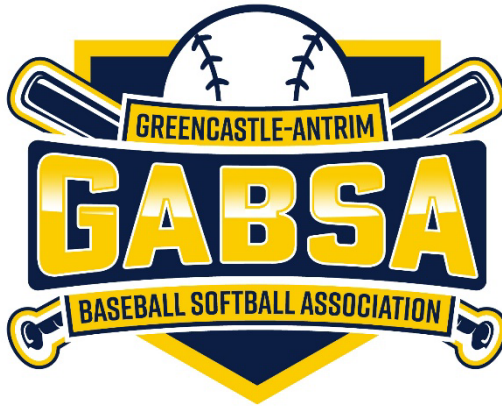




Greencastle-Antrim Baseball & Softball Association
